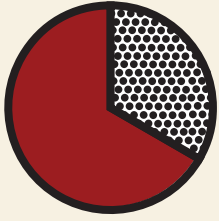

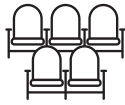
Strings Music Festival is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Ticket sales cover only **34% of our operating costs**. We rely on the support of generous donors to make our programming possible.

In order to produce 105 events per year, Strings provides artist fees, transportation, lodging, meals, and staff support for 230 musicians. In 2017, Strings provided:

for the community at the Yampa River Botanic Park, Bud Werner Memorial Library, area schools, and more.



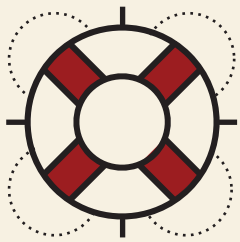
Entertainment and education for more than **24,000 audience members**

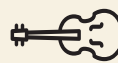


Strings School Days

Strings School Days is a unique music education program provided by Strings Music Festival at no cost to schools, students, or teachers. The program provides an opportunity for local students to watch, rehearse with, and perform alongside professional musicians.



Annually, the program serves nearly **3,000 K-12 students in 12 schools** throughout the Yampa Valley.
