

# **Strings Music Festival Lighting Designer**

## **Organization**

Strings Music Festival presents innovative programs of distinctive classical and popular contemporary music to the surrounding community of Steamboat Springs, Colorado and its visitors. Our intimate and friendly setting attracts people of all ages and backgrounds, and we enhance the cultural, educational, and entertainment experiences of our audience. No other organization brings world-class musicians to Northwest Colorado, creating the opportunities of a large city in a rural culture.

The summer festival season, now in its 35<sup>th</sup> year, features popular contemporary music, classical programs, youth and family concerts, and free community programs. Outside of the summer, Strings provides concerts as well as Strings School Days, a youth music education program. Strings Music Festival hosts over 100 events yearly, reaching over 24,000 audience members, and provides more than half of events at no cost. The festival's annual budget is \$3 million.

## **Position: Lighting Designer**

This position is full-time seasonal and located in Steamboat Springs, Colorado  
Mid June to late August preferred.

## **Roles & Responsibilities**

- Create lighting design for all events in Pavilion, and operate lighting for all events
- Create and maintain and adjust house lighting plot as necessary
- Coordinate with production staff regarding specific lighting requirements
- Assist with load-in and load-out of performances
- Manage and maintain lighting equipment, troubleshooting and repairing as necessary

- 5+ years of experience in lighting design and engineering
- Knowledge of ETC boards and dimmers
- Knowledge of three-phase power and hooking up tails
- Knowledge of multiple lighting boards and ability to help road crews patch into house system
- Ability to integrate into a highly collaborative small crew in a fast-paced work environment
- Ability to work evenings and weekends
- Basic knowledge of projectors a plus
